2017 NYS ELA Parent Information Workshop January 24, 2017

- Dates of the 2017 NYS ELA assessment are March 28, 29, 30.
- The NYS ELA assessment is taken by students in grades 3-8 and measures how well students are mastering the Common Core Learning Standards in English Language Arts.
- Assessment Format:
 - Each day, students will read between 2-5 passages and answer questions.
 - Questions will be in the form of multiple choice, short response and extended response questions.
 - Multiple choice questions require students to choose the correct answer from a list of several possible answers provided to them.
 - Short response questions require a few sentences, and extended response questions require students to show understanding in a well-planned and organized essay.
 - Samples of all 3 types of these questions from the 2016 NYS ELA are available on www.engageny.org.
- This assessment is an important way of measuring student learning, yet it is only one piece of information that shows what students fully know and are able to do.
- Your child's daily classroom instruction in a rigorous curriculum prepares them well for this assessment. In the coming weeks, students will also be working with additional instructional materials to support their preparation for this assessment.
